

RULE 418 DISPOSAL AND EVAPORATION OF SOLVENTS
(Adopted 6/6/72; revised 9/14/99)

A Person shall not, during any one day, dispose of a total of more than 1½ gallons of any Photochemically Reactive Solvent, as defined in Rule 101, or of any material containing more than 12 gallons of any such Photochemically Reactive Solvent, by any means which will permit the evaporation of such solvent into the Atmosphere.

Solvents should be recycled only through a commercial reclamation service or disposed of at a federal or state facility licensed to treat, store, or dispose of waste.
