



**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE IMPERIAL COUNTY  
AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT TO ISSUE AN AUTHORITY TO  
CONSTRUCT PERMIT TO IMPERIAL IRRIGATION DISTRICT, TO  
INSTALL AND OPERATE A DIESEL-FUELED ELECTRIC TURBINE AT  
THE BRAVO SUBSTATION IN CALEXICO, CA**

Pursuant to Rule 206 of Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (ICAPCD) Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Officer (APCO) has made a preliminary decision to issue an Authority to Construct (ATC) Permit to Imperial Irrigation District (IID) to install and operate a diesel-fueled electric turbine. The diesel-fueled electric turbine which is fueled with No. 2 diesel fuel is located at the Bravo Substation at 1134 E. Anza Road in Calexico, CA. Authority to Construct Permit No. 4652A-2 will include conditions to ensure that all ICAPCD requirements will be satisfied.

The public has an opportunity to submit comments regarding this proposed decision to the ICAPCD. Written comments will be received by the ICAPCD for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. The closing date for the submission of comments is March 24, 2023.
