



**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DECISION BY THE IMPERIAL COUNTY
AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT TO ISSUE A
RENEWAL TITLE V OPERATING PERMIT (V-2152)
AND RENEWAL ACID RAIN PERMIT
TO IMPERIAL IRRIGATION DISTRICT,
EL CENTRO GENERATING STATION**

Pursuant to Rules 900 and 901, of the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (ICAPCD) Rules and Regulations, the Air Pollution Control Office (APCO) has made a preliminary decision to issue a renewal Title V Operating Permit and renewal Acid Rain Permit to Imperial Irrigation District, El Centro Generating Station, located at 485 East Villa Avenue, El Centro, California. This facility has been determined as a major source of emissions for nitrogen oxides, carbon monoxide, sulfur dioxide, and particulate matter (PM10). The Title V Operating Permit will include conditions to ensure that all Federal and District requirements will be satisfied.

The Public has an opportunity to submit comments regarding this proposed decision and request that the ICAPCD hold a Public Hearing. Written comments will be received by the ICAPCD for a period of thirty (30) days after publication of this notice. The closing date for the submission of comments is April 7, 2023.
