## SCHEDULE 5 - GASOLINE DISPENSING EQUIPMENT

Any gasoline equipment, except bulk terminals which are subject to Schedule 4, at a single retail location, including stationary gasoline storage tanks, dispensers, and vapor recovery systems where required, shall be assessed a permit fee. Beginning in the year 2005, this permit fee shall increase at the rate of fourteen percent (14%). Beginning January 1, 2006, this permit fee will be adjusted annually by multiplying the base permit fee for the previous year by the average percentage rate for the month of August of the previous year (rounded to the nearest half dollar) which is derived by a fraction, the numerator of which is the Revised Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for All Consumers for the Rural Service Area #7 statistical area (All Items, Base 1982-84 = 100), (the "CPI"), and the denominator of which is the CPI for the same calendar month of the prior year. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event shall the permit fee be decreased and in no event shall any increase exceed 4% per annum, without formal action by the Air Pollution Control District Board. This permit fee shall be paid according to the following schedule:

Year 2024 \$469.00 plus \$92.50 per nozzle Year 2025 \$481.00 plus \$95.00 per nozzle
