Imperial County Air Pollution Control District – Request for Proposals (RFP) for 2025 Carl Moyer Program - Electric Charging Infrastructure Projects

The Imperial County Air Pollution Control District (ICAPCD) is accepting proposals to obtain electric charging infrastructure to support the emission reductions associated with Electric Vehicle (EV) deployment throughout the Imperial County. Submitted proposals must be for the installation of electric charging infrastructure projects. Eligible applicants are public and private entities within the Imperial County limits. Public entities include, but are not limited to, state, metropolitan, county, city, multi-county special district (e.g., water district), school district, university, and federal agencies and organizations. Private entities include, but are not limited to, private organizations, and corporations.

Proposals

Proposals must be in accordance with the California Air Resources Board's (CARB) 2024 Carl Moyer Memorial Air Quality Standards Attainment Program (Moyer Program) Guidelines. The applicant will be responsible for all permits and location approvals required for the project. Applicant is responsible for completing the Imperial Irrigation District (IID) Application for Service prior to beginning the project (https://www.iid.com/home/showpublisheddocument/12923/637853529709400000). All projects must be completed by Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program (EVITP) certified electricians per Assembly Bill 841.

The ICAPCD will select proposals that are eligible under the Moyer Program Guidelines. The funds available for this funding opportunity are \$283,596, which will be awarded according to the percentage of eligible cost for Moyer Program Infrastructure Projects (2024 Carl Moyer Guidelines). Applications will be considered on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications may be obtained by visiting the Imperial County website at https://apcd.imperialcounty.org/grants/.
